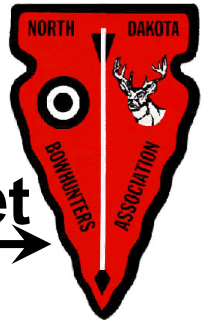

Banquet Guest Speaker: Greg Miller

Greg Miller is a die-hard deer hunter from Bloomer, Wisconsin. Greg's pursuits of trophy whitetails have led him to 18 different states and three Canadian Provinces. Over the past 22 years, Greg has had over 1000 articles published in national hunting magazines. He also has authored five books on deer hunting and co-authored more than 20 others. For four years, Greg was a co-host/co-producer and head writer for the extremely popular tv show, "North American Whitetail Television". But in early 2007, Greg resigned his position with "NAW-TV", formed a new production company and began filming for his own television show. That show, "IN PURSUIT with Greg Miller", currently airs on Outdoor Channel. Greg's son Jake is the co-host for the show.

Along with his duties as President/Executive Producer of In Pursuit Productions, Inc., Greg also makes guest appearances on "H.S. Outdoors" on The Outdoor Channel and "Thompson/Center's Pro Hunter Journal" on ESPN2. In addition, he is a co-host for "Realtree's Whitetail Country", which also appears on ESPN2.

For the competitive 3-D round, scheduled flights will begin every two hours, starting at 8 AM both days and pre-registration is required during the shoot which will continue up to 1/2 hour prior to the start of each flight. You may register in advance to reserve your place in a particular flight due to the fact that flight size will be limited to 30 shooters. During the 1/2 hour prior to the start of the flight, the shooters will be assigned to impartial groups of 3. After everyone has been assigned to their groups, the archers will shoot together as one entire group during the time it takes to finish the flight. Double scoring will be used, and both of your scorecards must have identical scores before being turned in. Cubs do not have to pre-register.

Current NDBA membership is required to shoot the competitive 3-D round and the 300 round requires NFAA membership.
